Each year, the Eugene School District 4j honors seniors who demonstrate academic excellence and community service. Eugene Honors Graduates are recognized by an honor seal added to their diploma and an honor cord to be worn at graduation.

**Requirements:**

- Earn a minimum of **25** credits by graduation
- Earn a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or above by the end of the second trimester
- Perform a minimum of 50 hours of community service

**Community Service Guidelines:**

- Community service hours may not be used for school credit.
- Teacher's Assistant hours cannot be counted as community service.
- There can be no financial payment for community service.
- Class time may not be used for community service; however, use of unscheduled school time is permitted.
- Volunteering to work for a family business is not acceptable as community service.
- Athletic participation is not acceptable as community service.
- Pep band, orchestra performances and participation in theater are not acceptable community service.
- Babysitting without pay is not acceptable as community service.
- For IHS students, only hours considered as service for the CAS requirement are counted.
- For overnight or full-day experiences such as volunteering at Camp Harlow or mission trips, students may count only the hours used in service to others (not eating, sleeping, traveling, or recreation) a maximum of 16 hours per day will be accepted.
- Service club meetings and conferences (e.g., NHS, Key Club, Interact, Lancer Pageant) will not count toward community service; only the service itself will be counted.
- Service performed remotely will be counted.
