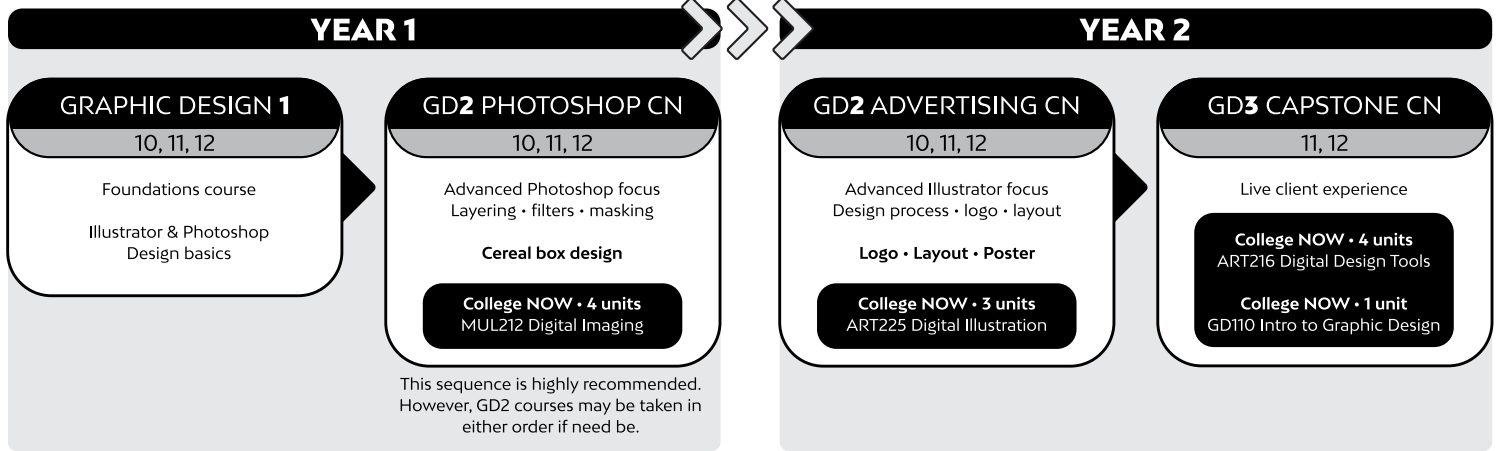

<p>Graphic Design 1</p> <p>This is the entry point to the Graphic Design Pathway. Students become proficient with Adobe Illustrator and Photoshop. Basic graphic design techniques and skills are foundational.</p>	<p>prerequisite: none 10 11 12 .5 credits Fall term</p>
<p>Graphic Design 2 CN Photoshop</p> <p>This is a college class. Students learn advanced Adobe Photoshop tools and skills to create a fully developed cereal box.</p>	<p>prerequisite: GD1 10 11 12 .5 credits 4 college units Spring term</p>
<p>Graphic Design 2 CN Advertising</p> <p>This is a college class. Students learn advanced Adobe Illustrator tools and skills to create professional graphic design pieces including logos, brochures, posters, and t-shirt designs.</p>	<p>prerequisite: GD1 10 11 12 .5 credits 3 college units Fall term</p>
<p>Graphic Design 3 CN capstone</p> <p>This is a college class. Students apply their skills while working with a live client to produce functional pieces of graphic design including business cards, shirt designs, posters, social media promotions, etc. Students can earn their LEAP during this class.</p>	<p>prereq: All 3 GD courses 11 12 .5 credits 5 college units Spring term</p>
