### **IMPORTANT TUITION INFORMATION**

*The Driver Education program is a self-supporting program. The cost of the program is shared by student tuition and state reimbursement. To be eligible for state reimbursement, thus receiving the reduced tuition price, the student must be 15-17 years of age and have a valid Oregon permit. **If a student is 18 years old, turns 18 prior to completing the program, obtains their license prior to completing the program, or they drop the course, they are NOT eligible for state reimbursement and must pay the additional tuition amount of \$210.***

## PROGRAM DETAILS Cost

**\$475:** Students 15-17  
**\$685:** Students 18+

Students who provide proof of free/reduced lunch status are eligible to receive a \$75 discount.

Full payment via debit/credit card is due when registering.

## Scheduling

The schedule provided is for **class time only.**

The six behind-the-wheel lessons are scheduled with the instructor outside of class time and will extend beyond the last class date.

## Requirements

Students must obtain their permit prior to registration as the permit number and issue date are required when registering.

Students must have a minimum of 15 hours of driving practice prior to their first behind-the-wheel lesson.

The first class session is a mandatory parent/student meeting.
